A) Immersion On-Site Camp 3 – 11 years old

Campers MUST be able to speak or repeat Mandarin for the entire duration of the camp, except for lunch and snack times. Some activities will involve the entire group, while others will be grouped by age.

We suggest that you at least sign up for **two executive weeks to see fluency results.**

At Planet Han, we turn language and history into a fun learning experience through hands-on activities, engaging games, arts and crafts, and cultural exploration. We are bringing Ancient China back to life this summer. Unique weekly themes will allow campers to discover architecture, fashion, entertainment, transportation, and more both in the Qin Dynasty and the modern world!

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B) 1s 2s On-Site Group Class 1,2 years old

This class is conducted completely in Mandarin! We pack each lesson with stimulating activities and fun games that teach useful everyday vocabulary and sentence patterns in a captivating way without relying on songs since Mandarin is a tonal language. The seven-week unit with weekly summer themes is just the right amount of time for students to retain the material, so we recommend enrolling in the full seven-week program to build more solid foundation of the language. *An adult is required to stay inside the classroom.*

ACCEPTANCE OF SIGNATURE REQUIRED BELOW

Approach and Platform: When permitted by applicable law and regulation, Planet Han intends (and prefers) to provide services in person at a Planet Han facility or other location for on-site camp. However, in the event Planet Han determines in its sole discretion that it is not able or permitted to provide in-person services for any reason, Planet Han reserves the right to provide services through alternative means, including without limitation, virtual or electronic means (e.g., interactive video conferencing or correspondence learning). I acknowledge that Class/Camp schedule and descriptions are subject to change. By executing these terms and conditions below, the undersigned acknowledges and agrees to abide by any such determination made by Planet Han with regard to the provision of services.

Limitation of Liability: I understand that Planet Han does not guarantee that my child will reach any specific level of performance or fluency. I hereby release Planet Han, its owners, directors, officers, instructors and other employees of any liability arising from the provision of, and participation in, Planet Han activities and services under this agreement in excess of the tuition fees paid for the registered session.

Assumption of Risk: My signature indicates that I give my specific consent to my child’s participation in all activities sponsored by Planet Han. I understand that part of the Planet Han program experience involves activities and group interactions that may be new to my child, and that they come with certain risks and uncertainties beyond what my child may be used to dealing with at home. I am aware of these risks, and I am assuming them on behalf of my child. I realize that no environment is risk-free, and so I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by Planet Han’s rules, and my child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them.

Medical: If the above-named student feels ill on any particular day, Planet Han asks the student stay at home, and not attend that day’s session. The obligation is on the student’s parent or legal guardian to notify Planet Han of any medical issues a student might have, including without limitation, medications or allergies. If a student will not attend a session for any reason, including health reasons, Planet Han must be notified of such absence at least one hour before the session begins. In the event of any medical emergency involving a student, Planet Han will contact the individuals listed on the student’s registration materials and advise that person of the situation. If necessary, the undersigned, as the student’s parent or legal guardian, authorize Planet Han to contact 911 in the event of a serious medical emergency involving a student as determined in Planet Han’s sole discretion. Any and all expenses that might accrue from any such medical emergency shall be the sole responsibility of the student’s parent or legal guardian. Planet Han endeavors to provide students with nut-free snacks and maintain a nut-free facility, but we cannot guarantee a nut-free environment. As such, the undersigned accepts this risk. If a student brings a snack to a Planet Han facility, such snack must be nut-free.

EPIPEN (for on-site campers): The undersigned is responsible for notifying Planet Han Inc. if the student has allergies that may require an EPIPEN. The undersigned is responsible to provide Planet Han Inc and its staff on its use.

Pick-up / Drop-off (for on-site campers): The undersigned must provide Planet Han with a list of individuals authorized to pick up a student. If someone other than an authorized person will be picking up a student, Planet Han must be notified of the individual’s identity and relation to the student in writing on that day (the latest) when the student is dropped off. Any student that is not picked up within 15 minutes of the scheduled pick-up time, Planet Han will apply a fee that will accrue at a rate of \$35 per half hour.

Refund, Cancellation & Make-Up Policy: **No make-up classes will be available. Registration fee is non-refundable. Camp tuition is fully refundable through April 30, 2024 less \$50 administrative fee. After April 30, 2024, no refunds no credit will be issued.**

Declined payment: Payment is due in full upon the submission of a student’s registration. A service charge of \$12.00 will be applied to returned checks, declined credit cards, or pre-authorized payment charge backs.

Jurisdictional Clause: It is agreed that any dispute or cause of action arising between the parties, whether out of this agreement or otherwise, can only be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in New York City and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of New York. The undersigned waives the right to a trial by jury in the event any such dispute goes to trial.

Other Policies: Unenrolled siblings of enrolled students are not allowed in the classroom (on-site and virtual) when class is in session. Planet Han reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual that is not a student while class is in session. Planet Han will not be responsible for any type of lost or damaged clothing or personal possessions. Planet Han is not responsible for any student’s personal valuables. I understand that Planet Han has the right to take my child out of the classroom if he or she becomes disruptive, and re-enter when my child is calm. Planet Han reserves the right to modify or cancel classes and themes based on enrollment or other factors.

Field Trip Permission: I give permission for my child to attend class trips with Planet Han. Children go to the playground/neighborhood/park almost every day, weather permitting. Special trips to local museums, community sites such as the fire house, post office, and library; and more are also on our plan. For trips outside of the immediate neighborhood, the children will travel by New York City M79, M86 buses.
