YOUNG CHILDREN Fall Semester: Sep 5,2024 to Feb 1,2025

Tots (10-20m) 45min/wk

An adult is required to stay inside the classroom.

We do not use baby language nor this is a free form playground. The students will learn to speak Mandarin like a native from the get go! We pack each structured class with stimulating activities with daily life relatable themes! We change the theme every six weeks; just long enough for children to retain the material.

Preschool Prep (18-30m) 1.5hr/session, register for 2x/wk or 3x/wk

First step of being independent! An adult must remain at Planet Han during the zentire class time.

This is a mini preschool where we follow a condensed version of Planet Han structured preschool structure. As students demonstrate their readiness, teachers assist students with the separation process. Gradual increase class time from 1.5hr to 3hr once a student is deemed ready to transition to their next milestone: Preschool Alternatives!

Typical morning: Choice Time - Movement - Snack and Story - Core Theme - Music – Art - Craft

Preschool Alternatives (2s, 3s, 4s) 3hr/session, register for 2x, 3x or 4x/wk

This class is drop off. Exercise gentle separation as needed for the first month of enrollment. The curriculum typically takes 2 years to complete.

Preschoolers learn Mandarin and acceptable social behaviors through creative, rich, engaging activities in a warm and nurturing environment. All subjects are taught in 100% Mandarin. The 3s are engaged in more advanced curriculum including Chinese characters recognition and tracing.

NON-FLUENT SPEAKERS Fall Semester: Sep 5,2024 to Feb 1,2025

2s (2 yr old) 1hr/session

This class is drop off. This class is for two years old who can take a theme-based class independently.

Focus: Vocabulary. The main purpose of this course is to introduce and develop oral communication skills with very short sentences.

3-5 (3-5 yr old)

This class is drop off.

Focus: Vocabulary and short sentences. The main purpose of this course is to introduce and develop oral communication skills with short sentences. We dedicate the last half hour to tracing and recognizing simple Chinese characters. Saturday 2 hours we include Han Trio where students take Cooking, Art and Science on rotation basis.

5-8 (5-8yr old)

This class is drop off.

Focus: Short sentences and paragraphs. We teach in Units where students learn similar sentence patterns with new vocabulary over a number of lessons. We dedicate the last half hour to reading a short paragraph and recognizing common Chinese characters. Saturday 2 hours we include Han Trio (5 yr old) or Pinyin (6-8 yr old).

9-13 (9-13yr old)

This class is drop off.

Focus: Longer sentences and dialogue. We teach in units where the students practice vocabulary and grammar in the form of dialogues. This class is taught using a more traditional (vs semi-progressive) approach. Writing homework will be given regularly.

Chinese Made Easy (13yr old+)

This class is taught using a traditional approach where textbook and workbook will be used. Students are required to purchase their own textbook and workbook for this class.



FLUENT SPEAKERS Fall Semester: Sep 5,2024 to Feb 1,2025

FL1 (Level 1) The curriculum typically takes 2 years to complete.

This class is drop off. **Focus**: Speaking short complete sentences, recognizing Chinese characters and learn simple tracing. This course is designed for fluent speakers under 5 years old who are not yet writing.

ADD: (i) Han Trio (Cooking, Art and Science on rotation.) See Supplemental Essentials Page for class details. (ii) Homework Help

FL2T (Level 1.5) The curriculum typically takes 3 years to complete.

This class is drop off. **Focus**: Reading and composing short sentences. FL2T is for fluent speakers who are ready to take on simple writing. Each week, we introduce a different passage. Required weekly homework includes memorizing and reciting class material, dictation, and writing.

ADD: (i) Pinyin (required for 6yr+ (ii) Lucie's Market (iii) Radical Learning (iv) Critical Thinking 1 (See Supplemental Essentials Page for class details). (v) Homework Help

FL2 (Level 2) The curriculum typically takes 3 years to complete.

This class is drop off. **Focus**: Reading and writing longer, more complex sentences. FL2 is for fluent speakers who can write short sentences on their own. Each week, we introduce a new three-paragraphs text. Required weekly homework includes memorizing and reciting class material, dictation, composing sentences, and writing.

ADD: (i) Radical Learning (ii) Critical Thinking 1 (iii) Radical Learning (See Supplemental Essentials Page for class details).

FL3 (Level 3) The curriculum typically takes 4 years to complete.

This class is taught using a more traditional approach. FL3 students learn to recognize more difficult Chinese characters and compose passages with multiple paragraphs.

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Approach and Platform: When permitted by applicable law and regulation, Planet Han intends (and prefers) to provide services in person at a Planet Han facility or other location. However, in the event Planet Han determines in its sole discretion that it is not able or permitted to provide in-person services for any reason, Planet Han reserves the right to provide services through alternative means, including without limitation, virtual or electronic means (e.g., interactive video conferencing or correspondence learning). I acknowledge that Class schedule and descriptions are subject to change. By executing these terms and conditions below, the undersigned acknowledges and agrees to abide by any such determination made by Planet Han with regard to the provision of services.

Limitation of Liability: I understand that Planet Han does not guarantee that my child will reach any specific level of performance or fluency. I hereby release Planet Han, its owners, directors, officers, instructors and other employees of any liability arising from the provision of, and participation in, Planet Han activities and services under this agreement in excess of the tuition fees paid for the registered session.

Refunds, Cancellation: Any tuition refund or credit will be subject to a \$50 cancellation fee. For any cancellation received by Planet Han within 14 calendar days prior to the start-date of the applicable semester, a 100% cash refund will be provided less the \$50 cancellation fee per student. For any cancellation received by Planet Han within 13 calendar days prior to the start-date of the applicable semester, a 100% credit only refund will be provided less the \$50 cancellation fee per student. For any cancellation received by Planet Han once the semester starts, a partial credit will be provided and may be applied to future Planet Han programs, based on 30% of the unused days less the \$50 cancellation fee. Make ups: Make up is given when a class or space is available. All make ups must be scheduled by email at least 24 hours in advance. All make ups must be used before the end of the semester. Any unused lessons cannot be refunded or as credits to be carried over to future semesters.

Payment Plan and Declined payment: Payment is due in full upon the submission of a student's registration. A service charge of \$20.00 will be applied to returned checks, declined credit cards, or pre-authorized payment charge backs.

Medical: If the above-named student feels ill on any particular day, Planet Han asks the student stay at home, and not attend that day's session. The obligation is on the student's parent or legal guardian to notify Planet Han of any medical issues a student might have, including without limitation, medications or allergies. If a student will not attend a session for any reason, including health reasons, Planet Han must be notified of such absence at least one hour before the session begins. In the event of any medical emergency involving a student, Planet Han will contact the individuals listed on the student's registration materials and advise that person of the situation. If necessary, the undersigned, as the student's parent or legal guardian, authorize Planet Han to contact 911 in the event of a serious medical emergency involving a student as determined in Planet Han's sole discretion. Any and all expenses that might accrue from any such medical emergency shall be the sole responsibility of the student's parent or legal guardian. Planet Han endeavors to provide students with nut-free snacks and maintain a nut-free facility, but we cannot guarantee a nut-free environment. As such, the undersigned accepts this risk. If a student brings a snack to a Planet Han facility, such snack must be nut-free.

EPIPEN: The undersigned is responsible for notifying Planet Han Inc. if the student has allergies that may require an EPIPEN. The undersigned is responsible to provide Planet Han Inc and its staff on its use.

Pick-up / Drop-off: The undersigned must provide Planet Han with a list of individuals authorized to pick up a student. If someone other than an authorized person will be picking up a student, Planet Han must be notified of the individual's identity and relation to the student in writing on that day (the latest) when the student is dropped off. Any student that is not picked up within 15 minutes of the scheduled pick-up time, Planet Han will apply a fee that will accrue at a rate of \$35 per half hour.

Consent: I hereby consent to authorize Planet Han the rights to publish, reproduce and use for advertising or any other purposes, any photograph, video image, audio recording or other likeness of my child. I hereby consent that any work produced by my child while at Planet Han may be displayed or reproduced by Planet Han in print media or electronic media such as a website for advertising or promotional purposes. Students shall retain copyright rights of his or her work. I hereby consent to authorize Planet Han to record classes; such recordings will be accessible to Planet Han students only for learning purposes.

Recording Prohibited: Recording by any means of any and all Planet Han materials, classes, activities, and/or the entire program without prior written consent of Planet Han is strictly prohibited.
